At its September 14, 2010 meeting, the Buffalo State College Council recommended; and President Aaron Podolefsky approved; that the student gallery at Upton Hall be named in honor of Dr. Margaret E. Bacon.

Margaret Eschner Bacon graduated from then State Teachers College in 1941 with a BS in Art Education. Margaret went on to earn a doctorate degree and dedicated her life to the service of higher education as an art education professor at the University of Buffalo and Daemon College. In recognition of her long history of philanthropic support for a variety of initiatives at Buffalo State, Dr. Bacon was presented with the Chair's Recognition Award from the Board of Directors of the Buffalo State College Foundation in 2008.
