


Student Instructions for Navigating ACTFL Test Registration

To register for your online assessment, please follow the following steps:

Step 1: Go to: www.languagetesting.com to purchase your test and setup your account

Step 2: Go to Certifications for Individuals and select Certification Types

Certifications for Individuals






Step 3: Select or type the language you wish to test in and click Next



Step 4: Select "I am a student or teacher and need to take an ACTFL assessment as a requirement for my academic program."




Step 5: Type in **SUNY Buffalo State** and click continue






Step 6: Select the OPI and click continue to schedule the test






Step 7: Select Web-based proctoring – Examity, your time zone, the day and time you wish to test






Step 8: At this point you will need to create your own account or log in if you have an existing LTI account





Step 9: After creating your account or logging in, place the order – **please review your order prior to clicking Place Order**

• You'll be emailed the test instructions once you have ordered your test or tests.



Notes:

- Five ACTFL assessments are available. SUNY Buffalo State accepts only the OPI for college credit.
- Examinees requesting Auxiliary Aids and Modifications should register first and then send an email accommodations@languagetesting.com. LTI requests that this be sent 10 business days before your test date but after you have scheduled your test.
- The ACTFL assessments that students order in SUNY Buffalo State's account are included in the official certificate group. ACTFL offers other assessments that do not carry an official test certificate.
- ACTFL has a 90-Day Retest Policy. Each candidate is eligible for a one-time retest waiver to retake the test (their 2nd attempt) within the 90-day period. After that, they will need to wait 90 days to retest.



- Sending a certificate to SUNY Buffalo State is not required, since it can be accessed by SUNY Buffalo State via the LTI client site.
- Express Rating Service guarantees ratings within 14 business days (weekends and holidays excluded) of the test administration date for the OPI (Oral Proficiency Interview). Standard rating turnaround is 2-4 weeks.
- To ensure that your results are matched with your MDID# and for transcript evaluation purposes; please complete a Test Entry Request Form after you take your ACTFL exam.
