

# CAMPUS HIGHLIGHTS 2021–2022

Buffalo State proudly celebrated its 150th anniversary during the 2021–2022 academic year.

The community officially kicked off the sesquicentennial at Buffalo State College Day on September 17. The festivities began in the Performing Arts Center at Rockwell Hall with a live presentation featuring remarks, official proclamations, a short video history of the college, dance and musical performances, and the debut of Buffalo State's new alma mater. Buffalo State alumni Claudine Ewing, '92, anchor at WGRZ-TV, and Matt Bové, '13, sports director at WKBW-TV, served as masters of ceremonies for the event, which was followed by an outdoor reception. That evening, Buffalo City Hall and other major city landmarks, as well as Rockwell Hall and the Burchfield Penney Art Center, were illuminated in orange in honor of Buffalo State's anniversary celebration.

Additional milestone anniversary programming was held throughout the year. Through the Civic and Community Engagement Office's 150th Anniversary Challenge, students, faculty, staff, and alumni who contributed at least 150 hours of volunteer service in the community were recognized for their efforts with a 150th Anniversary Service Challenge certificate of completion and a commemorative pin.

The sesquicentennial celebration officially concluded with the college's 150th Commencement ceremony on May 21.









# **APPOINTMENTS**



Buffalo State selected Randyll Bowen, '99, as vice president for enrollment management. Bowen, who officially joined the Buffalo State community on May 2, previously served

as the vice president for enrollment management at Hilbert College in Hamburg, New York. Prior to Hilbert, Bowen was the vice president for student life and enrollment management at D'Youville University. He earned a B.S. in communications from SUNY Brockport in 1994, an M.S. in student personnel administration from Buffalo State in 1999, and an Ed.D. in organizational leadership from Grand Canyon University in 2018.

## **FACILITIES**

Frank & Teressa's Anchor Bar, the iconic restaurant where Buffalo-style wings were born, opened a location in Buffalo State's Campbell Student Union for the fall semester. It marked the restaurant's first venture on a college campus.

Buffalo State hosted an open house and ribbon-cutting ceremony on October 1 to celebrate the completion of renovations to two key academic spaces: the Academic Commons within E. H. Butler Library and the Science and Mathematics Complex (SAMC). The Academic Commons—a \$16 million reconstruction project begun in 2018—houses the Writing Center, the Math Center, Tutoring Services, the Educational Opportunity Program's Academic Center for Excellence (EOP-ACE), the Academic Advising Center, and Student Accessibility Services. The SAMC, which began as an ambitious \$100 million renovation project 10 years ago, boasts a multi-story glass atrium, upgraded research and teaching facilities, an advanced imaging suite, greenhouses, and the newly imagined Whitworth Ferguson Planetarium. The fourth and final phase of SAMC construction was completed in January 2021.


A new Integrated Studies in Nanoscience and Nanotechnology Center on campus aims to bring together several disciplines at Buffalo State with the goal of taking a comprehensive approach to emerging medical, technological, environmental, and transportation fields. The center involves faculty members from several disciplines, including chemistry, mathematics, engineering technology, physics, economics and finance, and political science and public administration.



# **ACCOLADES**

laya Mohamed, a health and wellness major, was among 173 student civic leaders from 38 states, Washington, D.C., and Mexico named a 2022–2023 Newman Civic Fellow by Campus Compact, a national nonprofit organization that works to advance higher education's public purposes. The fellowship recognizes students who stand out for their commitment to creating positive change in communities locally and around the world. Mohamed volunteers with FeedMore WNY, the Buffalo City Mission Shelter, and Buffalo City Thrift Store, among others. The program is supported by the KPMG Foundation.

Douglas Hoston Jr., a completion coach in the Student Leadership and Engagement Office, was selected as a 2021–2023 fellow at Buffalo State through the State University of New York's Promoting Recruitment, Opportunity, Diversity, Inclusion, and Growth (PRODiG) initiative.

Jevon Hunter, Woods-Beals Endowed Chair in Urban Education in the School of Education and chair of the Social and Psychological Foundations of Education and Adult Education Department, was named a member of the 2021–2022 class of the American Council on Education (ACE)
Fellows Program. The program gives interested educators the opportunity to develop leadership skills and learn about the culture, policies, and decision-making processes of another institution. The program is meant to train educators looking to move into administrative roles in the future.


More than 20 Buffalo State alumnae, faculty, and staff members were recognized by Buffalo Business First in its 2021 Power 200 Women countdown, showcasing Western New York's most prominent female leaders. Crystal Peoples-Stokes, B.S.Ed. '74, M.S. '02, majority leader of the New York State Assembly, placed fifth on the list, while Buffalo State President Katherine Conway-Turner ranked ninth.

Buffalo State ranked prominently on a number of lists in the U.S. News & World Report 2022

Best Colleges publication. The college ranked

10th in the North Region for economic diversity,

20th for social mobility, and tied in 32nd place for top public colleges in the North out of







more than 170 institutions in the region. The recognitions that Buffalo State received in social mobility and economic diversity reflect the urban-engaged college's ability to help low-income and first-generation college students obtain an economically stable and fulfilling life after graduation.

Joshua Vacanti, a 2016 graduate of
Buffalo State's music program, was one
of 54 contestants selected to participate
in Season 21 of NBC's popular singing
competition, The Voice. The Lockport native
made it to the Top 8 before being eliminated.
He studied privately with Buffalo State
associate professor of voice Holly Bewlay
and sang with the Buffalo State Chamber
Choir and the Vocal Jazz Ensemble under
the direction of Victoria Furby, chair and
associate professor of music.

Sixteen Buffalo State faculty and staff members were recognized with President's and Chancellor's Awards for Excellence for their extraordinary efforts on behalf of the college, the State University of New York, and the greater community during the Faculty and Staff Recognition Ceremony on October 14 in the Performing Arts Center at Rockwell Hall.

Iyanna Williams, an exceptional education and childhood education major, was among the inaugural class of Educational Opportunity Program (EOP) Student Ambassadors announced by the State University of New York. She was one of 21 current EOP students from 20 SUNY campuses chosen to mentor other students, create a student EOP support network across the SUNY system, advise the chancellor on strengthening the program, and help inspire more students to seek opportunities through EOP. Each ambassador receives a stipend of \$5,000 to carry out the role.

Five Buffalo State students enrolled in the Educational Opportunity Program were chosen for the SUNY Pre-Med Opportunity Program, a new SUNY-wide initiative aimed

at helping qualified EOP students successfully prepare for medical school. The initiative was created to help address persistent racial and income disparities in the medical professions. Buffalo State students Ayan Ali, Nayelisi Cano, Unique Phyall, Cindy Sanchez, and Jennifer Sosa, composed nearly a quarter of the initial cohort selected for the program, which launched in summer 2021 with 25 students.

Buffalo State ranked 34th out of 1,550 benchmarked colleges and universities in CollegeNET's Social Mobility Index (SMI) for 2021. The SMI, now in its eighth year, measures the extent to which four-year colleges and universities educate economically disadvantaged students (those with family incomes below the national median) at low tuition and graduate them into well-paying jobs. Buffalo State ranks highest among schools within the State University of New York (SUNY) system and continues to be the highest-ranked four-year institution in Western New York. Last year, it ranked 35th in the index.

## PROGRAMS AND PARTNERSHIPS

Buffalo State Intercollegiate Athletics announce plans to add three new sports—acrobatics and tumbling, women's wrestling, and men's volleyball—over the next two years. Acrobatics and tumbling and men's volleyball will begin competition for the 2023–2024 season, while women's wrestling will begin in the 2024–2025 season. These additions will bring the total number of Bengal intercollegiate sports program to 21.

Buffalo State is working with SUNY Erie
Community College to increase the number
of community college students who go on to
earn a bachelor's degree through a new transfer
alliance. The two schools are among 30 institutional teams that were selected nationwide to
participate in the first cohort of the AspenAASCU Transfer Student Success and Equity
Intensive that began last November and runs
through October 2022. The initiative is designed
to improve transfer students' transition, success,
and graduation rates.

Buffalo State's School of Education launched a new initiative called "Find Your Path Back to Teaching," which is aimed at potential teachers who either let their New York State teacher certification lapse or never received it in the first place. The new initiative, designed to alleviate teacher shortages, provides individualized programming to get back on the path to become a certified teacher in New York State.

Through a partnership with the Buffalo Broadcasters Association (BBA), the Communication Department launched the TV series Broadcasting Buffalo, which aired on Saturday evenings in March and April 2021 on WNYO-TV (MyTV Buffalo). This gave journalism and media production majors an opportunity to write, shoot, produce, and direct a real program for broadcast. Students in two courses produced 11 episodes, focusing on topics such as Buffalo's rebirth, the first 50 years of broadcasting in Western New York, and Ukraine.

Vida Vanchan, professor of geography and planning, and James Golden, assistant professor of social work, were the first two faculty members selected for the new Social Justice Faculty


Externship program, a collaboration between the Equity and Campus Diversity Office and

the Civic and Community Engagement (CCE)
Office. An anonymous donor has funded this
civically engaged social justice initiative supporting
Buffalo State's urban-engaged anchor mission.
Each faculty member and partner organization
selected to participate in the annual externship
receives a \$900 to \$1,000 stipend per project.

The Muriel A. Howard Honors Program now includes 550 students, more than double the number enrolled in fall 2017. In fall 2021, a record 172 new students entered the program—160 freshmen and 12 transfer students. The program was established in 1984 as a way to offer academically challenging opportunities to high-achieving and intellectually committed undergraduate students. Of the students accepted to the program, about 45 each year are awarded the Muriel A. Howard Scholarship, which provides \$1,250 per semester and is renewable for up to four years.

A new partnership between the Buffalo State
Data Science and Analytics Interdisciplinary
Unit and Roswell Park Comprehensive Cancer
Center offers Buffalo State students paid

research internships in the growing field of genomics. The 15-month DSA Genomics
Fellowship provides \$33,000, including \$15,000 for tuition and fees, to qualifying students pursuing a master of science in data science and analytics at Buffalo State. Fellows complete 30 credit hours of coursework at Buffalo State and conduct full-time research for 12 weeks—with access to professional laboratories—during the summer at Roswell Park.

Buffalo State's Exceptional Education Department launched a new master's degree program in applied behavior analysis (ABA). The two-year, six-semester M.S. program prepares students to work as independent practitioners with individuals who have autism and other behavioral health conditions. The program is designed for students who have undergraduate degrees in psychology, education, special education, or a related field that addresses learning and behavioral problems. Upon receiving the degree, graduates must pass a state and national exam for licensure, which will enable them to practice as licensed therapists in ABA, one of the fastest-growing occupations in the country. ABA specialists are hired by school districts, hospitals, and other organizations.

## **EVENTS**


Buffalo State hosted the 2022 SUNY Undergraduate Research Conference at the Science and Mathematics Complex on April 23. The multidisciplinary daylong event brought together undergraduate students and faculty mentors from SUNY schools for sessions devoted to student presentations, a SUNY Graduate School and Career Fair, and professional development workshops for students and faculty. About 360 students from 28 SUNY colleges and universities attended the event.

The Performing Arts Center at Rockwell Hall was delighted to welcome back in-person audiences in fall 2021 with a lineup of award-winning musicians, comedians, and authors. The series was highlighted on October 6 by an Evening with David Sedaris, one of America's preeminent humor writers. Known for his personal essays and short stories, Sedaris has been nominated for five Grammy Awards (Best Spoken Word and Best Comedy Album). His pieces regularly appear in the New Yorker, and the first volume of his diaries, Theft By Finding: Diaries (1977–2002), was a New York Times best seller.

Buffalo State hosted a free screening of the documentary FOSTER and Q&A with Deborah Oppenheimer, Buffalo State alumna and Academy Award-winning film producer, on October 21 in the Burchfield Penney Art Center. Oppenheimer also conducted a master film class on October 20 in the LoRusso Alumni and Visitor Center. Oppenheimer visited the college as part of Beyond Boundaries, the campus's screening and discussion series focused on social justice issues.


The Whitworth Ferguson Planetarium played host to four members of the world-class Buffalo Philharmonic Orchestra, who recorded several pieces for the BPO's "Out of the Box" series. The series features BPO musicians traveling Western New York to showcase architectural treasures and unique landmarks in the area. The planetarium, which reopened to the public in October 2021 following a complete remodeling, includes several new state-of-the-art software and projection systems that create a 360-degree visually captivating experience for students and provide countless teaching opportunities for disciplines across campus.

Auditorium in honor of the Reverend Martin Luther King Jr. and Black History Month. The event, which was also part of the college's 150th anniversary celebration, was sponsored by the Equity and Campus Diversity Office. Ross, a Buffalo native, became the first African American woman to hold the position of U.S. attorney in Western New York.

Buffalo State, in partnership with National Grid, offered a free technology camp for local high school students July 18–29 on campus. Future Innovators in Tech and Engineering hosted 50 rising juniors and seniors from Buffalo and first-ring suburbs and included electrical engineering technology (EET) and creative and critical thinking lessons. Faculty and alumni from the EET Department and the International Center for Studies in Creativity provided instruction over the two weeks. An \$80,000 grant from National Grid made the camp possible.

Buffalo State's 14th annual Runway fashion show, with a theme of "Pushing for Progress," was held on April 30 in the Sports Arena. The show, which was open to the public, highlighted the collections of five senior designers in the Fashion and Textile Technology Department, along with designs from other students in the program. Runway also collaborated with students in the Africana studies program who were involved in the planning process and presented their spoken-word pieces during the show.

Buffalo State conferred degrees on roughly 1,500 undergraduate and 725 graduate students during its 150th Commencement celebration on May 21 in the Sports Arena. Degree candidates were honored at 9:00 a.m. and 1:00 p.m. baccalaureate ceremonies and a 5:00 p.m. graduate ceremony. Letitia A. James, the 67th attorney general for the State of New York, delivered the Commencement address and Joseph "Grandmaster Flash" Saddler, DJ, producer, and Rock and Roll Hall of Famer, Darryl W. Dennard, '81, award-winning broadcast journalist, and Eric Greenberg, '78, award-winning journalist, communications and outreach director, and interfaith leader, received SUNY honorary degrees. The College Council Medal was presented to Todd W. Brason, '85, chairman and founder of Willcare, and Gary M. Brost, chairman and CEO of Strategic Investments & Holdings Inc.

## GRANTS AND GIVING

Buffalo State College's 25th annual Bengala, held May 7 in the Science and Mathematics Complex and adjoining courtyard, raised a record amount for scholarship funds—almost \$500,000. This marked the first in-person gala the college has held since 2019. The event attracted close to 500 guests and among those in attendance were past Bengala and board chairs and 100 new friends of the college. The presenting sponsor was M&T Bank. Bengala is the signature fundraiser for honors student scholarships. Since it began, Bengala has raised roughly \$6 million.


Marie J. (Gagnon) Marillo, '56, left a \$2.1 million endowment to the Speech-Language Pathology Department. The endowment will allow the department to spend \$75,000 annually for at least the next decade and will be used to support speech therapy education. Marillo, who worked as a speech-language pathologist for more than 40 years, bestowed the gift to the college when she died in 2010, to be disbursed upon the death of her husband, Chris A. Marillo. He died in 2019.

The Anne Frank Project (AFP), now in its 13th year at Buffalo State, received a \$1 million endowed gift from Donn Youngstrom, who served as a faculty member in the Theater Department for 24 years until his retirement in 2018. The funds will support AFP's scope in three main ways: to hire two part-time teaching artists to assist with the AFP in the Schools initiative; to support high-profile keynote speakers for the social justice festival each fall; and to develop a new AFP Global Learning Lab, which will allow Buffalo State students to interact with students living in partner countries, including Rwanda, Kenya, and Switzerland.

Six bright, energetic figures with bubbly colors, ranging in height from 5 to 12 feet, created by artist Shasti O'Leary Soudant were permanently installed on the plaza outside the Burchfield Penney Art Center as a tribute to the strength and power of women and girls thanks to a generous gift from the Junior League of Buffalo (JLB). Entitled Do Not Mistake Our Softness for Weakness, the public sculpture was dedicated









during a ceremony hosted by the JLB to mark its 100th anniversary on September 21. The sculpture was made possible by both private donations from individual members of the JLB and the community through a fund independently established by the organization.

The My Brother's Keeper Teacher Opportunity
Corps II grant gives the School of Education more
than \$193,000 annually to continue and expand
its Urban Teacher Academy and Buffalo Urban
Teacher Pipeline Residency Program. The new
state grant was awarded in early September, with
support from Buffalo State distinguished alumna
Crystal Peoples-Stokes, '74, '02, New York State
Assembly majority leader, and runs through 2026.

Shirley Hudders, a longtime volunteer and trustee emerita of the Theodore Roosevelt Inaugural
Site Board of Directors, made a gift to the site
earmarked for fellowships at Buffalo State. The
\$2,500 Hudders TR Inaugural Site Masters

Fellowship will be awarded to one Buffalo State student enrolled in the history and social studies education graduate program each fall for use the following spring semester over the next 10 years, beginning in spring 2022.

For the third time since 2012, Buffalo State's Great Lakes Center (GLC) was awarded a grant through the United States Environmental" Protection Agency (EPA) to continue monitoring "benthic invertebrates in the Great Lakes. The entire grant of \$6.7 million was awarded by the EPA Great Lakes National Program Office to Cornell University and Buffalo State. The grant is funded through the Great Lakes Restoration Initiative, and Buffalo State will receive more than \$3 million, which will fund research through the beginning of 2028. The grant will benefit Buffalo State students by funding positions for graduate student researchers and undergraduate technicians in the GLC. It will also include independent research opportunities.

# RECOMMENDATIONS FOR ACTION 2022–2023

SUNY Buffalo State has four major recommendations for action during the 2022–2023 academic year: 1.) Middle States Reaccreditation; 2.) Strategic Plan Operationalization; 3.) Financial Sustainability Plan; and 4.) Presidential Search.

MIDDLE STATES REACCREDITATION

This year, we see the conclusion of Buffalo State's preparation for the Middle States Commission on Higher Education (MSCHE) accreditation review with boots on the ground spring of 2023. The campus steering committee with feedback and contributions from the campus working groups and campus leadership will submit the completed self-study at the end of the fall semester. Chair of the MSCHE campus evaluation team will conduct their preliminary visit in early November 2022. The purpose of the preliminary visit is to introduce the team chair to the institution, its people, and its environment so that the chair and team of peer evaluators can complete the review efficiently and effectively. This is an important step for the entire campus and, through this process, the campus will document how we believe we

meet or exceed the seven MSCHE standards under review. Successful accreditation affirms the excellent work of the campus, provides peer assessment of areas that need attention, and endorses the campus to receive federal financial aid to support our students.

### STRATEGIC PLAN OPERATIONALIZATION

As we began the journey to develop our 2022-2026 Strategic Plan, we approached and then concluded a milestone period for Buffalo State: our sesquicentennial. The celebration marking the 150th anniversary of our establishment as an educational institution was filled with a great deal of joy, reflection, remembrance, and hope for our continued bright future. We now move forward with a bold Strategic Plan to guide us during the next four years. During this academic year, the vice presidents will work with the academic schools, departments, administrative and support units, and centers to operationalize the Strategic Plan by developing clear, measurable, and attainable goals based on the five pillars. After which, they will then implement those plans and provide regular updates to the college community regarding their progress.





### FINANCIAL SUSTAINABILITY PLAN

In December 2021, President Conway-Turner shared an overview of the budget picture at Buffalo State and indicated that the college would work collaboratively toward a multiyear plan to steady our financial footing to expand our enrollment portfolio and secure a financially stable and sustainable future. Now that the Financial Sustainability Plan has been developed through the input garnered from community members, the college will continue to work toward the seven priorities and provide regular updates of its accomplishments. The seven priorities are: 1.) increase enrollment; 2.) increase community directed programs; 3.) increase collaborations to promote the use of campus facilities; 4.) continue successful fundraising activities; 5.) continue workplace efficiency plans/develop collaborations with other SUNY campuses; 6.) focus attention on advocacy goals with the State of New York; and 7.) continue workforce planning to address the budget deficit.

### PRESIDENTIAL SEARCH

With the recent announcement of our current President Katherine Conway-Turner's retirement, the College Council has begun the process to find a successor to become the Tenth President of SUNY Buffalo State. The College Council will work with the campus community and key stakeholders, in accordance with the SUNY guidelines for presidential searches, to put together a diverse and representational cross-section of individuals to work with the SUNY Chancellor to ensure a smooth selection process and transition to our next president.


